US TRADE MOVES MAY ESCALATE AS OTHERS RETALIATE: AZEVEDO



Recent decisions by the US to unilaterally raise tariffs and target the rules-based regime of the World Trade Organization (WTO) may very well escalate into a potential global trade war, WTO Director-General Roberto Azevedo (pictured) said on Tuesday. "The WTO does not, as an institution, take a stance. But I'm very concerned because of these measures. Because, whatever reasons has a very real possibility of escalation because of the possibility of responses from other partners with trade restrictive measures as well," Azevedo said.

File affidavit on safety of A320neos: Delhi HC

The Delhi High Court on Tuesday directed the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) to state on affidavit that the remaining fleet of aircraft of this model, which had not yet been grounded, were safe and airworthy.
